Background & Objectives

- Research was required to identify awareness among the adult population, of the proposed World Heritage Park solution, to the current M3 Motorway's path through the Tara/Skryne Valley.
- The solution proposes that the Tara Landscape be made into a World Heritage Park, to include a better road than currently available using a 2+1 lane solution (not a motorway) and incorporating increased coach and bus routes and a rail link. The M3 Motorway would proceed to the Valley and beyond the Valley thus preserving the heritage section.
- Investigation was also required into the level of agreement among the population as to whether they support the current agreed M3 format, or support the new World Heritage Park proposals.

Questions Asked

Q.1 A proposed solution to the debate regarding the M3 Motorway and the preservation of the Tara /Skryne Valley was put before the cabinet earlier this year. The solution proposes that the Tara Landscape be made into a World Heritage Park, to include a better road than currently available using a 2+1 lane solution (not a motorway) and incorporating increased coach and bus routes and a rail link. The M3 Motorway would proceed to the Valley and beyond the Valley thus preserving the heritage section. Which of the following best describes your knowledge of this proposed solution before today?

Research Methodology

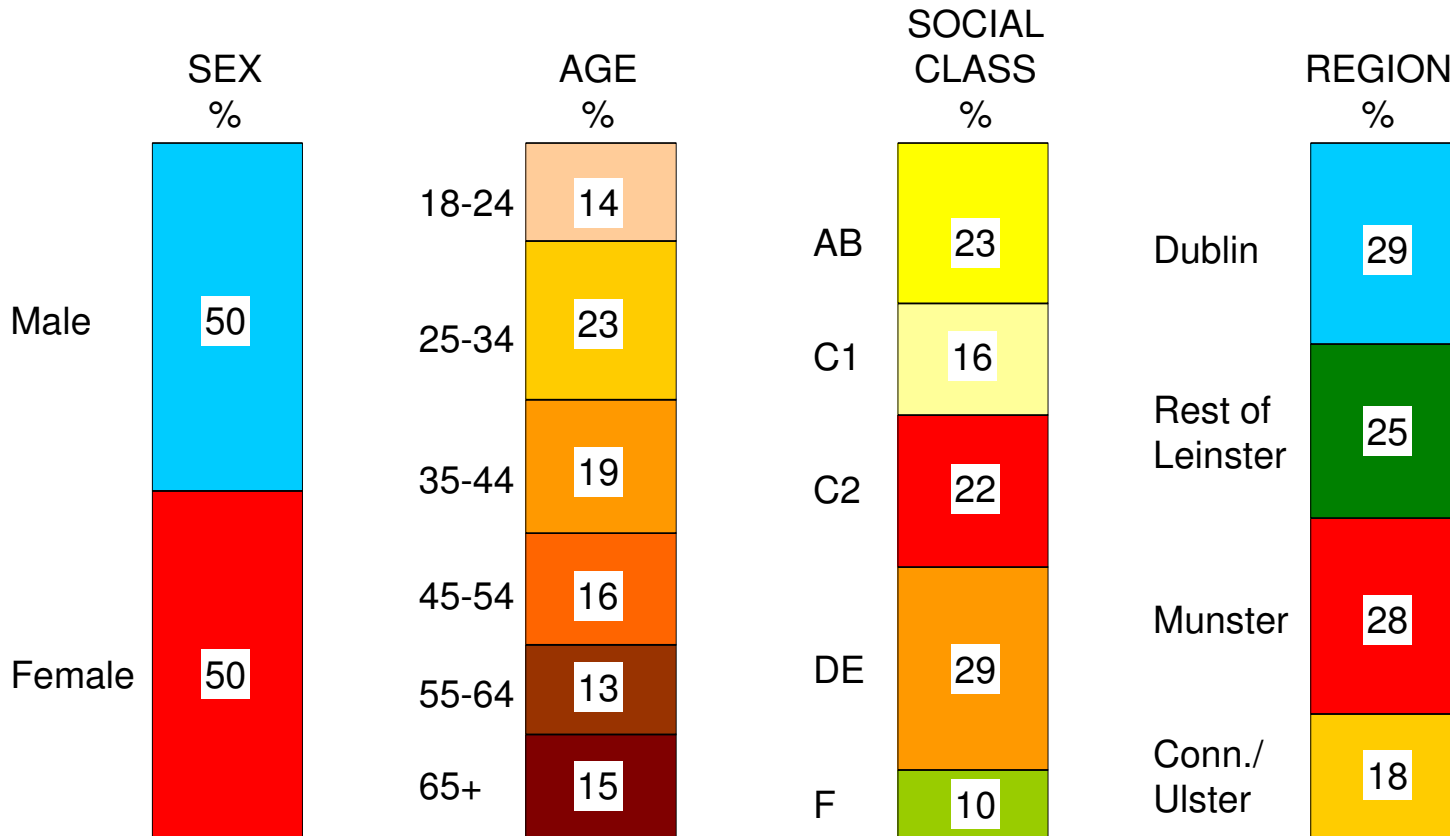
- 1,002 interviews were conducted by phone using a random digit dial sample to ensure all households including ex-directory and mobile only were covered.
- Quotas were set and final data weighted to ensure that the sample is randomly representative of the Irish population aged 18+.
- Fieldwork conducted in 21st – 23rd January 2008.
- During this report we have shown significant difference of + or – 3% as follows:
 - Higher than average 
 - Lower than average

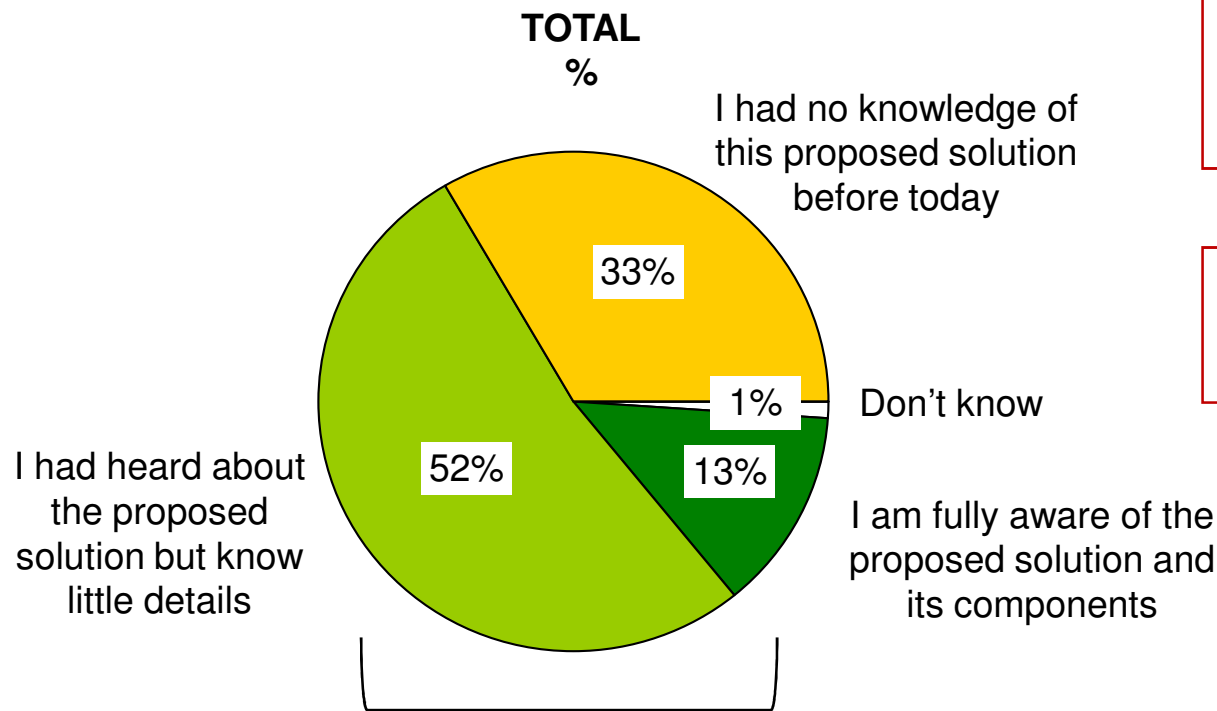
Key Findings

- Only just over 1 in 10 (13%) of all adults are fully aware of the details of the proposed World Heritage Park solution to the M3 Motorway through Tara/Skryne Valley. While 2 in 3 Irish adults claim to have previously heard of the proposed solution, most of these are not aware of the details.
- Those in younger age groups of 18-44 are considerably more likely (46%) to be unaware of the proposed solution than the total population (33%).
- When asked directly, almost two thirds (62%) of all Irish adults agree that the current format set down for the M3 is wrong, and that alternatives should be found to protect the heritage sites.
- Despite being previously unaware of the proposed solution, it is those in younger age groups who are most likely to state that the current format is wrong and alternatives should be sought to protect the heritage sites within the valley.
- This younger age group appear to be a key target for increased exposure to the proposed solution, which in turn build may help build support for the World Heritage Park at the Tara / Skryne Valley.
- When provided with the two options, of firstly keeping the M3 in its current agreed format, or secondly implementing the proposed alternative including the World Heritage Park - over half (58%) support the proposed Heritage Park solution, while less than a third (31%) agree they would prefer to keep the M3 running through the valley as already agreed.

1 in 3 adults are completely unaware of the proposed World Heritage Site by-pass solution, with just 1 in 8 fully aware of the proposed solutions. Younger adults most likely to be unaware and older adults most likely to be aware of the proposed solution.

18-24 year olds are least likely to be aware of the proposed solution with 55% citing no knowledge. 25-44 year olds (40%) also cited high levels of no knowledge

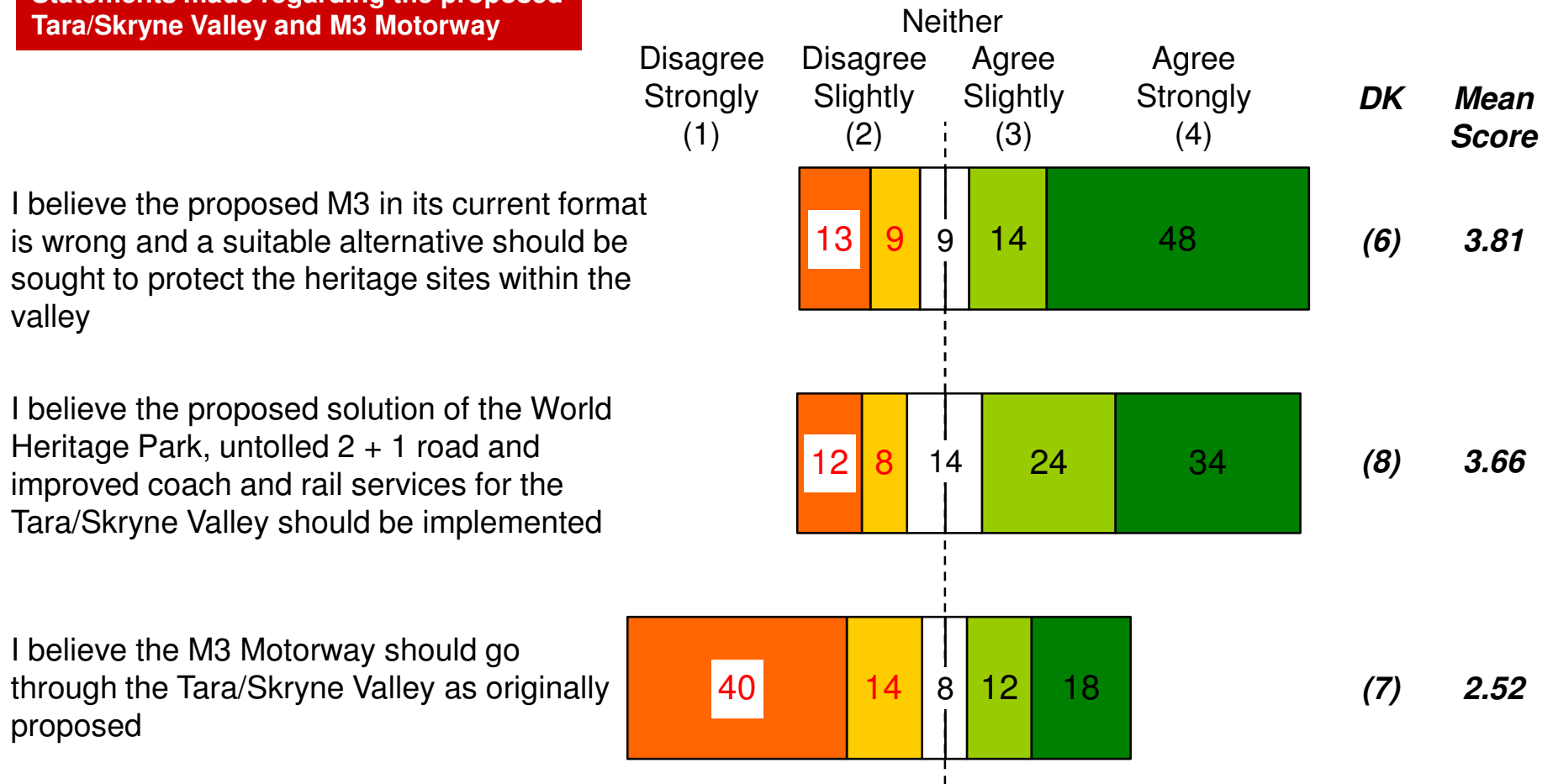
Those aged 55+ are most likely to be fully aware of the proposed solution (24%)

The majority of all Irish adults believe in protecting the heritage sites within the valley and believe the M3 in its current agreed format is wrong. Over half (58%) agree that the proposed Heritage Park solution should be implemented, as opposed to less than a third (30%) who support the current solution

Little difference is seen in support for the proposed alternative World Heritage Site solution, which remains strong among most demographic groups, but it is supported least by older adults aged 65+.
